DMV Fees are changing 1/1/2026

There is a registration fee increase for most vehicle types as of 1/1/2026. This also changes the fee necessary to clear permits with MVED. You can always find our most current fee chart online at

Dealers can process title and registration transactions

Dealers can contact the DMV to get set up as a self plater. This allows the dealer to process title and registration transactions versus visiting a DMV office. Email DMV for more info at dmvthirdparty@utah.gov

MVED licenses are now online & online salesperson transfers

MVED licenses are now online. You can now log into your MVP account and print those licenses anytime. When we process a transaction for a license you will get an email reminding you to log in and print. You can also print out replacement licenses if they are lost.

If you have a salesperson wanting to work for your dealership you can apply to transfer their existing sales license in your MVP account.

MVED Advertising Laws & Rules

MVED has seen an increase in advertising violations recently. Please read and review the laws and rules that cover advertising. Utah Code Ann § [41-3-210](#) and Administrative Rule [R877-23V-7](#).

TC-466 Transaction Disclosure Form

Please do not send a copy of the [TC-466](#) in with your title/registration documents to the DMV. That form should be kept in the dealer jacket. A motor vehicle dealer must complete and present this form to a potential retail vehicle buyer before the sale is finalized. This form is not required for auction sales or fleet transactions.

Non-Resident Sales Tax Exemption Form TC-721A

This form has been changed slightly. Instead of keeping it in your dealer files, you must go to your TAP account and upload the form within 45 days of the sale. Instructions can be found on the most recent version of the form. <https://tax.utah.gov/forms/current/tc-721a.pdf>

Monthly Reports of Sale are due on the 10th of each month for all Dealers

The [TC-928](#) Monthly Report of Sale needs to be filed monthly, even if you don't have any sales for that month. This report includes wholesale sales, sales to non Utah residents, and sales in which you did not issue a 45 day dealer permit. Instead of filing the paper form, you can also report your monthly reports of sale via your account on the MVP portal <https://www.mvp.tax.utah.gov/>

This report is also used to help determine the number of dealer plates you can renew each year. Some common rejects on submitted reports are for:

- Missing dealer numbers —Dealer numbers are required anytime you sell to a Utah dealership
- Missing odometer readings—Vehicles 2011 and newer require an odometer reading, unless exempt, e.g., off highway vehicles, trailers, heavy trucks
- List the grand total of sales for that month on Page 1
- Watercraft should **NOT** be reported on the TC-928

Clearing Temporary Permits

Fee Schedule for permits issued on or after 01/01/2026:

Passenger/Lt Truck Vehicles	\$72.25
Passenger/Lt Truck Vehicles with expired permit	\$144.50

Vehicles weighing in excess of 14,000 lbs gross weight are charged a ¼ year registration fee. Please call MVED at 801-297-2600 for the amount. The weight of the vehicle must be listed on the temporary permit. If the permit has expired a 100% penalty will also be assessed.

Motorcycles	\$73.00
Motorcycles with expired permit	\$146.00

Off Highway	\$41.50
Off Highway with expired permit	\$83.00

Snowmobile	\$28.50
Snowmobile with expired permit	\$57.00

Trailer	\$49.50
Trailer with expired permit	\$99.00

The UCA for temporary permits is § 41-3-302 and Administrative Rule 877-23V-5. It is illegal to alter any part of a temporary permit. An MVED temporary permit should **never be issued to a watercraft** – contact the DMV to inquire about watercraft permits. All temporary permits and applicable fees should be sent to: **Motor Vehicle Enforcement Division at 210 N 1950 W, SLC UT 84134**. Please make check payable to: **Utah State Tax Commission**. Anytime the DMV registration fees change, it effects the fees due to clear a permit. Always look for the most recent chart to determine the fees due.
