## **DMV Fees Changed 4/1/2026**

There is a registration fee increase for most vehicle types as of 4/1/2026. The DMV change also affects the fee necessary to clear permits with MVED. You can always find the most current fee chart online at

## **Dealers can process title and registration transactions**

## **MVED licenses are now online & online salesperson transfers**

MVED licenses are now online. You can now log into your MVP account and print those licenses anytime. When we process a transaction for a license you will get an email reminding you to log in and print. You can also print out replacement licenses if they are lost.

## **MVED License Fees & Permit Book Fees changing 10/1/2026**

All MVED licensing fees (for businesses and individuals) plus the temporary permit books will be changing as of 10/1/2026. New forms will be published in advance on our website. Please use the most current forms as of 10/1/2026 with the updated fees.

## **2026 Law Updates**

**Following are some of the bills that relate to vehicles and businesses that passed in 2026.**

**HB 228-** Bill amends provisions related to motor vehicle title brands. Effective date January 1, 2027.

Brand is defined as a label on a title certificate identifying a motor vehicle as: fire damaged, flood damaged, gray market (Mfg outside of US, not intended for sale in US, and does not meet federal or state motor vehicle safety or emission standards), hail damaged, stolen/recovered, or rebuilt and restored.

Motor Vehicle Division will check NMVTIS (after receiving application for new Utah certificate of title) for salvage brands, total loss, or damaged. The division will also indicate "Odometer Discrepancy" if the motor vehicle has such a discrepancy.

**HB 381-** Bill amends provisions regarding electric assisted bicycles and other devices.

Statute 41-6a-511 (Effective January 1, 2027) states a commercial seller of any new or used vehicle shall clearly and conspicuously provide a disclosure (in Subsection (6)(b) to a prospective purchaser at the time of sale and in any advertising materials, online, website, or social media post promoting the vehicle if the vehicle: has fewer than four wheels, powered by an electric motor, and is not an electric assisted bicycle. (Infraction)

**SB 190-** Bill provides an option for a trailer to have a lifetime registration during a person's ownership of it. (Non-commercial, under 41-1a-228) Effective January 1, 2027.

**HB 57-** Bill provides an option for an Auction Dealer license and amends provisions related to vehicle consignment sales and motor vehicle auction licenses.

## **TC-466 Transaction Disclosure Form**

Please do not send a copy of the **TC-466** in with your title/registration documents to the DMV or to MVED. That form should be kept in the dealer jacket. A motor vehicle dealer must complete and present this form to a potential retail vehicle buyer before the sale is finalized. This form is not required for auction sales or fleet transactions. NOTE this form is being revised. Be sure to download the new revised form and use the new version as of **7/1/2026**.

## **MVED Advertising Laws & Rules**

MVED has seen an increase in advertising violations recently. Please read and review the laws and rules that cover advertising. Utah Code Ann § 41-3-210 and Administrative Rule R877-23V-7.

## **Non-Resident Sales Tax Exemption Form TC-721A**

This form has been changed slightly. Instead of keeping it in your dealer files, you must go to your TAP account and upload the form within 45 days of the sale. Instructions can be found on the most recent version of the form.

Do **NOT** send this form into MVED.

## **Monthly Reports of Sale are due on the 10th of each month for all Dealers**

The TC-928 Monthly Report of Sale needs to be filed monthly, even if you don't have any sales for that month. This report includes wholesale sales, sales to non Utah residents, and sales in which you did not issue a 45 day dealer permit. Instead of filing the paper form, you can also report your monthly reports of sale via your account on the MVP portal [mvp.tax.utah.gov](http://mvp.tax.utah.gov)

This report is also used to help determine the number of dealer plates you can renew each year. Some common rejects on submitted reports are for:

- Missing dealer numbers —Dealer numbers are required anytime you sell to a Utah dealership
- Missing odometer readings—Vehicles **2011 and newer** require an odometer reading, unless exempt, e.g., off highway vehicles, trailers, heavy trucks
- List the grand total of sales for that month on Page 1
- Watercraft should **NOT** be reported on the TC-928
- Only one month per report. Do not combine multiple months on the same report.

## **MVED Permits will be changing to be online**

Big changes are coming to MVED permits as early as July. Permits numbers will be purchased online and permits will be printed by the dealership. The vehicle owner/vehicle information will be uploaded to the MVP website. Registration fees will be collected at the time of permit issuance and will vary depending on vehicle and fuel type. This process will eliminate the annual permit audit. This will require the business to provide purchaser/vehicle information and payment of registration fees via the portal shortly after the permit is issued.

## **MVP Web Logins Will Be Deactivated For Owners During September 2026**

This is for any web login created prior to January 2025. An email notification will be sent to the web address on file when the deactivation is done.

When web logins were first set up, many business owners were providing their SSN information to employees to set up accounts on their behalf. With the changes coming in January 2027 for E-titles, this would enable an employee to see/make changes to an owner's personal vehicles.

Due to these changes in what is visible under a log in and other security reasons, we are deactivating any owner log ins created prior to January 2025 and requiring ALL owners to set up a new log in.

Owners please DO NOT share your social security number! Once the owner sets up a log in they will receive a PIN to share with an employee/manager/CPA that they wish to grant account access to. That person will set up their own log in which is slightly more limited in access.

Anyone with access to your MVP account will also see / be able to make changes to the vehicles titled to the business in the portal. This is access they did not have prior to January 2026 when E-titling started for dealers.

Do you want this person with access to the business account to view a list of each car you personally own OR only what the business owns?

Business owners will have an option to link their personal vehicle records to their MVED business account log in OR to set up a separate log in for their personal vehicles. The personal log in will be set up through the Division of Motor Vehicles.

Business owners should also check the access under their business log ins and remove anyone that should no longer have access. This should be done regularly to ensure that no one has access that shouldn't.
