Vintage Vehicle Insurance Affidavit

To be registered as a vintage vehicle, a motor vehicle or motorcycle must primarily be a collectors item that is at least 30 years old and used for participation in club activities, exhibitions, tours, parades, occasional transportation and similar uses. Vintage vehicles may not be used for general, daily transportation. See Utah Code §41-21-1(5).

Registered vintage vehicles, model year 1983 and newer, must get an emission inspection in Cache, Weber, Davis, Salt Lake and Utah counties UNLESS the vehicle is covered by an insurance type specific to vehicle collectors.

Use this affidavit to certify your vehicle qualifies for an exemption from the emission inspection requirement. Before filing this affidavit, contact your insurance provider to verify you have the proper insurance type.
